Key duties/responsibilities for quality manager

- Works with Authorities to implement workforce plans; oversees all production activities within the department; participates in interview process and new employee orientations as needed and appropriate.
- Ensures that all supervisors are appropriately trained and that the supervisors appropriately train line workers.
- 3. Provide quality related support for the Plant.

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- Gather and analyze transactional data and identify opportunities for improvement.
- Supervise the Accounts Receivable function to ensure proper billing and collection.
- Conduct occasional field inspections of product, delivery and installation quality and provide feedback as needed. Gather/maintain data to ensure issues are being addressed and corrected in a timely manner.

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- Develop relationships and provide feedback to all areas of the organization.
- Manage & participate in continuous improvement initiatives.

- Maintains work area consistent with 5S program and training.
